and used drugs. Several times a day she drank 'vodka', beer and other drinks... several times the police took her for being drunk.

On the 18th of July 2010 she came to Restoration House. She got involved into the life of the house and restoration began without suffering much withdrawal symptoms. She had a good rest during summer at the camp; she had great time together with Arika, me, Olga and the boys from the house.

In September she joined Nikolskoye school. She is in 9th grade now. Her plans are to finish the school, enter college to become a nurse, not to drink and not to smoke any more. She has changed a lot. She is learning how to cook, clean. She's become more responsible. She's chosen good friends among her classmates. She's reading the Bible and praying. She wants to go back to her hometown and help other girls to quit drinking."

We arrived late afternoon to Restoration House greeted by hugs, smiles and then handshakes from Oleg and Yulia our newest residents. Both are a bit on the shy side until you get to know them. We'll talk more about Oleg in a future Newsletter.

That's all it took and the walls were down. In just a matter of two days she initiated a routine of finding me in the morning to give that "fatherly" hug and blessing and each afternoon a hug and the opportunity to chat.

According to Inga, "Yulia Drozdova was born on December 10, 1994 in a town named Lepietsk. She's been sent to Restoration House by a social center of Lepietsk. She's got a mother, a step-father and a sister. Why she was sent to us was because she didn't live at home for one month, she went to the disco clubs all the times and she didn't study. She drank alcohol, smoked

Yulia and others like her are the reason that we are building Restoration House for Girls. We were not able to complete the project with all volunteers and staff as planned, instead we will have to hire people to complete the walls and floors.
